- Seeks to situate the death of an infant within the context of faith
- Offers the opportunity to unite the grieving parents and family members to our merciful God
- Is a celebration based on Christian faith and hope

Nothing can prepare a parent, family or friends, for a child dying prior to birth, due to miscarriage, accident or other reason. # \*\*A Request for Needed Assistance

Recently all of our parish religion instructors attended a training class for PSR teachers that was held at Immaculate Conception parish in Dardenne. On the one hand, all of our teachers returned *highly enthused* by what they learned and, in particular, by all of the materials and programs available for our PSR students. On the other hand, they all voiced their sincere concern that, because of the current state of our resources, we are currently unable to take advantage of the great wealth of possibilities out there. Many programs require TV monitors and DVD players that we do not have and our textbooks date back to 2007 or earlier. In the interests of full disclosure, it's not so much that the content of our textbooks is out of date (After all, the Bible itself is over two to three thousand years old and it remains valid...), as it is that twelve years of service has worn them out and they need to be replaced.

The cost of TV monitors and DVD players for the classrooms will be approximately \$1,000. The cost of new grade-school textbooks will be approximately \$5,000.

Both I and our PSR teachers are requesting any monetary assistance you would care to contribute in order to update our educational resources. Envelopes can be found at the end of each pew and they can be placed in the regular collection offering on Sunday or given directly to Fr Henke after Mass. I consider this to be a very important initiative and I am grateful for your help.
